## SANITATION 2019

**If you made any changes to your sanitation services your bill will reflect that change. For those who opted-out: your curbside sanitation service ends December 31, 2018 . Please Note with the Holidays your garbage may be delayed by one day depending on what day the holiday falls on. Waste Management will not pick up on Christmas Day, New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day and Thanksgiving. During time of inclement weather please listen to radio as service may be delayed. We will also have that information posted on our webpage and Facebook. We also want to remind people that it is not a FREE service. We get billed monthly by Waste Management and this is paid with user fees. If you have a dispute about your garbage bill, please notify the township board in writing in a timely manner. The treasurer does not have authority to adjust the bill without board approval.**

Please note that our office hours are Tuesday and Thursdays from 10:00 A.M-3:00 P.M. We also have a mail slot to the right of the front door which goes into a locked box. We no longer give out an automatic receipt, however if you wish to have a receipt, please include a note in with your payment and Julie can send you one.
