2021 Sanitation Rates and Guidelines

Sanitation rates for 2021 will be as follows: **Yearly \$245; Seasonal \$130; Double \$490.** Garbage is limited to 6 bags per week. You have until October 1st to contact the township office of any changes to your service for the upcoming year. *Allouez township enters into a contract with Waste Management so we must give them an accurate count for the coming year. If you choose to opt out, you will not be eligible for service for the year 2021.*



Allouez Township Cleanup



Township Cleanup Day will be held Saturday, September 19th from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. **You must be a township resident and have a voucher to participate.** The cost will be \$10 per load for current sanitation customers or \$20 for non-customers. Limit 2 loads. No exceptions. Vouchers will be available for purchase during normal office hours, beginning August 4th thru September 3rd. No vouchers will be issued after September 3rd. You must have your voucher(s) with you on the day of the cleanup.

Assessor Inspections



A Note from the Assessor: I will be starting my review of all the buildings in the Township starting June 8, 2020 (Monday) in Ahmeek Village, weather permitting. I will get the next area posted on Facebook and the Township Website to let people know what area we are working on at the time.

This inspection is being done in order to review and verify the building information that is on the record card for each parcel in the Township. This review is necessary because of the new AMAR reviews that the State is conducting where they are reviewing parcel record card information. I will be visiting each parcel that has a building to take a new picture of the structure and to measure the structure for the sketch on the record cards. If you have vacant land, there will be no review.

I will not be inspecting the inside of the structure. The property owner does not need to be home at the time of the inspection. We will be wearing masks when we come to your door to let you know that we are there, to keep social distancing. I do ask that you please tie up or enclose your dog if it is outside so that no one gets bitten during the inspection. Individual appointments cannot be made, since this work will be done when the weather is cooperating, so any given date and time cannot be guaranteed.
