Time was allowed for public comment on non-agenda issues.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: Per Fire Chief, Gary Bracco, two calls since the last meeting—both car accidents. New firehall continues to progress. \$5000 grant from the Portage Foundation has been deposited into the 501(c)(3). The new tank came for the brush truck. Motion by Supervisor Aho, seconded by Trustee Kaura, to approve up to \$1000 for a battery operated chainsaw and up to \$600 for a baffle system, both payable from the Restricted Fire Fund. All ayes; carried.

MEDICAL FIRST RESPONDERS: Some calls since the last meeting, but Gary was unsure of how many.

PUBLIC WORKS:

Motion by Treasurer Newman, seconded by Supervisor Aho, to hire Bjorn Excavating to remove the dead tree in front of the township hall for \$600. All ayes; carried.

Kermits Kids is done, so the youth are no longer working.

Sanitation: Motion by Treasurer Newman, seconded by Supervisor Aho, to allow property #101-53-000-001 at 1027 Ahmeek Street to opt-in to garbage October 1, 2021, at a pro-rated yearly rate, to allow property #102-27-150-004 to opt-in for the current year at the seasonal rate of \$130.00 and to allow property #102-22-250-003 to opt-out of yearly garbage (they haven't lived there all year). All ayes; carried.

Sewer: Treasurer Newman sending out final notices soon.

Supervisor's report: Michigan Treasury Department reported that we passed our AMAR Review.

Treasurer's report: Motion by Treasurer Newman, seconded by Supervisor Aho, to set the clerk as administrator, and the treasurer as a user, for the online banking at Superior National Bank. This is necessary for the treasurer to do remote deposits. All ayes; carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Fire Hall Project: John Paul Pietila gave an update that construction is going fairly smoothly without significant problems. Motion by Supervisor Aho, seconded by Trustee Kaura, to pay DP Construction \$269,607.78 from the fire fund. All ayes; carried.

Sewer System Project: Email update from Emmett Bjorn stated (in summary) that the Rural Development application meeting will be August 24, the compliance/violation letter should be received from EGLE soon; and the sewer rate increase upcoming will add about \$5/month to the average residential user.

NEW BUSINESS:

Recreation Plan/Seneca Lake Expansion: Brian Sickler checked with the DNR, and they offer parks and recreation grants to local units of government. Supervisor Aho will check on the application process.

Karrio property near cemetery: Supervisor Aho will ask owner about the possibility of an easement purchase for the township cemetery purposes.

Water Connection Township Hall: tabled until we get some prices.

Sewer rates: Motion by Supervisor Aho, seconded by Treasurer Newman, to adopt Resolution 2021-8-19-001 to Set Rates and Charges for Sewer Usage. Roll call vote: "Aye": Treasurer Newman, Trustee Kaura, Supervisor Aho, Trustee Haataja, Clerk Haataja. "Nay": none. The Supervisor declared the resolution adopted.
