OLD BUSINESS:

Sewer System Project:

Emmett Bjorn from UP Engineers was present to update the Board on the sewer system upgrade project which is funded through a grant/loan program from the U.S. Department of Rural Development. Project is looking to be completed by October, and is about 95% completed at this point.

Final lift station was installed, and owner training was given. More training will be for pump and control panel maintenance will be provided in the weeks to come. There are some remaining funds in the project that the township board should look into purchasing some equipment to help maintain the drainfields as well as providing a way to block off access to the fields by ATVs or a portable generator to run the pumps/lift stations if the power were to go out.

Mr. Bjorn was requesting RD Draw request #12 totaling \$742,931.40 for U.P. Engineers invoice and B&B Contracting.

With the government shutdown, the draw request will be sent to Rural Development but doubtful that the money will be transferred to make the payment.

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Motion made by Trustee Johnson, seconded by Trustee Tarvis to adopt the resolution to approve draw request #12. Roll Call Vote: All Ayes; carried.
