OFFICER REPORTS –

Supervisor's report: The Allouez Township Community building is in need of a new coffee machine and microwave. A Motion by Trustee Tarvis, Seconded by Treasurer Newman was made to purchase a new coffee machine and microwave with a limit of \$500 and \$300 respectively. All ayes; Carried.

Supervisor Aho will be speaking with the attorney to get some answers regarding the Fire Millage Renewal and the sale of township property.

OLD BUSINESS:

Sewer System Project:

Emmett Bjorn from UP Engineers was present to update the Board on the sewer system upgrade project which is funded through a grant/loan program from the U.S. Department of Rural Development. Project is looking to be closed out by July 1st, 2026.

Mr. Bjorn was requesting RD Draw request #15 totaling \$3,019.38 for U.P. Engineers invoice.

Motion made by Trustee Johnson, seconded by Treasurer Newman to adopt the resolution to approve draw request #15. Roll Call Vote: All Ayes; carried.

Mr. Bjorn also presented change order #10 for the Sewer project for improvements to drainfield #7, which would cost around \$22,000 of work for B&B Contracting.

Motion made by Trustee Tarvis, seconded by Trustee Johnson to approve this change order. All ayes; motion carried.

Mr. Bjorn also stated that the township should look at other avenues on the sewer project to spend remaining grant money.

Sanitation Fund Discussion: The board discussed ways to spend down the sanitation fund. Some items talked about were a tire cleanup or Spring/Fall Cleanup. There was also talk about WUPPDR looking into recycling and materials management options.

NEW BUSINESS:

Poverty Exemption: Supervisor Aho presented the Poverty Exemption Resolution. Motion made by Supervisor Aho, seconded by Trustee Tarvis to adopt the resolution to approve the resolution. Roll Call Vote: All Ayes; Motion Carried.

Fire Millage Renewal: The Fire Millage Renewal is up for voting. Supervisor Aho is looking into the renewal with the Township Attorney.

Property Sale Discussion – Near American Legion: The parking lot by the American Legion is currently owned by the Township. Jay Isaacson asked about being able to purchase this lot as he is purchasing the American Legion building. They were hoping to look into closing on the property as early as May. Supervisor Aho was instructed by the board to follow up with the township attorney about this process.

Other Discussion: A Special Meeting: Budget Workshop was planned for March 4th at 5:30PM. Budget hearing date is still to be determined.
